

Tablecloth

Tablecloths start white and can be customised all over. 115gsm and 220gsm tablecloths are designed to sit over any table, whereas 235gsm stretch tablecloths are produced to fit specific size tables.

Key Points

- ♦ Full colour dye sublimation printed.
- ♦ Lead time of 3 – 5 working days, express service available.
- ♦ A range of standard sizes are available, but we can also produce custom sizes.
- ♦ Stretch tablecloths have hooks to slot onto the feet of specific size tables to create a tight fitting graphic.
- ♦ Our most popular size is 3m x 2m, which fits a 6ft x 2ft exhibition trestle table.

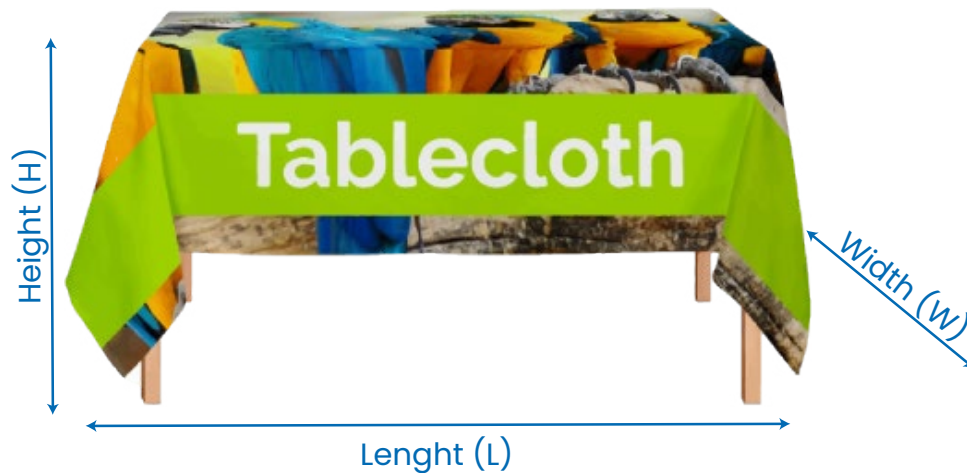

What size tablecloth do I need?

There is not a 'one size fits all' with tablecloths and ideally you need to know the size of the table that the tablecloth is going on. Exhibition tables/trestle tables are typically 6ft x 2ft and take a 3m x 2m tablecloth, but if you have a custom size table here is how you calculate the size of the tablecloth.



To work out the size of tablecloth you need to do the following:

- ◊ Length of tablecloth = $H + L + H$
- ◊ Width of tablecloth = $H + W + H$

This will create a tablecloth that has a drop to the floor on all edges. If you only want a drop on the front or not on the sides then just adjust the length and width accordingly.
